Overview

This 5-day lecture course prepares information security professionals for the CISSP examination. Lectures cover in detail the ten security domains required for the CISSP examination. Students attending this course receive a Certificate of Completion. Exam registration and credential verification are not included in this course.

Audience

Candidates interested in earning the CISSP certification must have a minimum of 5 years of full time security professional work experience in at least 2 of the 10 domains (ISC)² CISSP CBK®, OR 4 years of direct full time security professional work in at least 2 of the 10 domains of the CISSP CBK, plus a four year degree prior to taking the CISSP examination.

Associate of (ISC)² status is attainable to those individuals who are knowledgeable in key information security concepts and can pass the examination, but still need more work experience to qualify for the CISSP certification.
